On December 1, 2025, Stated Clerk Don Mountan wrote to the Saint Andrew's Chapel Session: "Presbytery will not approve a call for a PCA TE to serve at SAC as a non-PCA congregation." In light of that understanding of Article V of the Standing Rules of the Central Florida Presbytery, and in light of the vote of the Saint Andrew's Chapel congregation on December 14, 2025, to withdraw from the PCA per BCO 25-11, I understand that I cannot remain both a member of Central Florida Presbytery and a pastor at Saint Andrew's Chapel. Therefore, I respectfully withdraw from the Central Florida Presbytery of the Presbyterian Church in America and request that my name be removed from the roll in accordance with BCO 38-3.a.

I remain grateful to the Lord for the numerous friendships that He has been so gracious to provide throughout the PCA and the Presbytery. I write with sincere love for my faithful brothers within the Presbytery whom I have served alongside, and I will continue to pray that the Holy Spirit would use us—sinners saved by grace—to serve Him, His people, and the lost throughout Central Florida and the world, so that the Great Commission of Jesus Christ would be fulfilled and that our just and merciful God would receive all the glory.
